- 8. Mark ends his gospel in an interesting way. Alvin suggested that it invites us to write our own story into God's ongoing story; how we will we respond to Jesus, the Son of God. Jesus has risen, but has He risen in you? Why is this question "the question" when it comes to Easter and the good news of Jesus?
