Children's Ministry Director

Position Description

The Children's Ministry Director will fulfill God's vision for Mount Olive EFC through the building up of the church for the ministry to which they are called. They will have a heart for discipleship, children/families, outreach and leadership development, showing an ability to lead the church to God's heart.

Qualifications

- A person of Christian experience and established character, qualified according to the standards of 1 Timothy 3:2-7 and Titus 1.
- Shall be willing to be a, or become a licensed minister of the EFC.
- Shall have experience and passion for the work of Children's ministry.
- Shall be able to work on a team in fulfilling God's vision for Mount Olive EFC.
- Shall be committed to regular practice of spiritual disciplines and lifelong learning.
- Shall not be solely responsible to DO the ministry, but rather train, encourage, and build up the church to DO the ministry.
- Shall demonstrate a commitment to Mount Olive EFC's statement of faith, Vision, and Values.
- Biblical Education: Preferred B.A. in Biblical Studies or equivalent in experience or Elementary Teacher Education training.

Primary Responsibilities:

- 1. Implement systems of administration that help all Children's ministries of Mount Olive to be organized and well run.
- 2. Facilitate, and/or lead, and/or equip Children's ministry in events including (but not exclusive to) MAPS and VBS.
- 3. Facilitate and/or plan effective children's ministry leadership training events or opportunities.
- 4. Lead and/or teach in some ministry events as required.
- 5. Identify strategies and design children's ministries concordant with the vision Mt. Olive's Children's ministry and for the increased effectiveness of the mission.
- 6. To administrate the Plan 2 Protect Program within Children's ministry.

Secondary Responsibilities:

- 1. Oversee Children's ministries for Sunday mornings and for special events, as needed.
- 2. Ministry Involvement: We would encourage participation in the work of the larger context of the EFCC and local ministerial as opportunity and interest presents itself.

Accountability:

The Children's Ministry Director shall be accountable to the Lead Pastor and ultimately to the congregation through the Board. This accountability is to be maintained through written reports, regular consultations with the Lead and other pastoral staff, and weekly staff meetings.
