1. What insight, principle or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eye opening or troubling? Please explain.
2. What is the worse Church conflict you ever saw? What is the worse family conflict you ever saw? Why do you think unity is so hard to have with those closest to us?
3. Read Psalm 133. In what sphere do you desire this verse most, right now, and why? Your blood family, your Church family, or the human race family?
4. Read John 17:20-21. What was Jesus' prayer for us, and why was it so important to him? How does the unity of Christians help people believe in Jesus, and how might the disunity of Christians hinder our witness to those outside the faith?
5. Read Romans 12:18. In what ways does this verse challenge you? Who in the "everyone" that Paul mentions, is most difficult for you to live at peace with?
6. Often our contribution to strife and discord are because of our own jealousy, envy, selfish ambition or un-forgiveness. How have you seen this to be true in your own life or others? In what way right now do you need to deal with your stuff?
7. 4 areas of discipleship (following Jesus) are our relationship to: God, the church (God family), our blood family, and the world (our witness). In which of these area's do you need to make peace right now?
